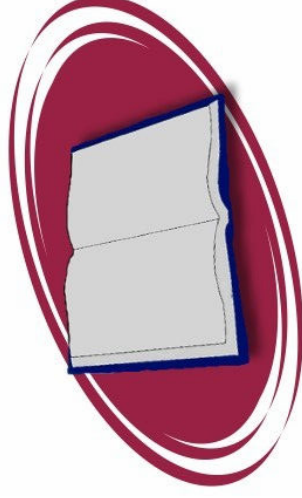

Library Card Replacement Fees

Unrestricted (14 yrs & older) \$3.00
Restricted (birth to 14 yrs) \$1.00
Processing fee (lost material): \$5.00

The Louisville Public Library requires that your card be renewed every three (3) years. There is a replacement fee for unexpired lost or damaged cards.

Library Card Information

Library cards are issued free of charge for the following categories of patrons:

- New adult patrons with correct and current identification.
- Young patrons of any age, with the signature and correct and current identification of a parent or legal guardian. The parent’s card must also be in good standing.
- Educators are eligible for a special teacher card that allows them to check out materials for an extended period of time. To be eligible for a Louisville Teacher Card, one’s personal library card must be in good standing.

Your Louisville Public Library card may be used at the following locations:

- Massillon Public Library and branches
- Stark County District Library and branches

ONLINE SERVICES – With your library card you can do the following from home or office:

- Check your borrowing record online
- Renew most materials
- Receive overdue notices
- Receive courtesy notices to remind you of upcoming due dates
